As a contract manufacturer in the electronics and electronic equipment industry, KINERGY Group is committed to conducting business in a manner that respects, preserves, and improves the environment.

The latest Directive 2011/65/EU on the Restriction of the use of certain Hazardous Substances in electrical and electronic equipment (RoHS) was issued in June 2011. The RoHS directive restricts the use of the following, with no more than the maximum concentration value by weight in homogeneous substances on product sold into European markets:

Lead Pb	0.1%
Mercury HG	0.1%
Cadmium Cd	0.1%
Hexavalent Chromium Cr6+	0.1%
Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBB)	0.1%
Polybrominated Diphebyl Ethers (PBDE)	0.1%
Bis(2-ethylhexyl) Phthalate (DEHP)	0.1%
Benzyl Butyl Phthalate (BBP)	0.1%
Dibutyl Phthalate (DBP)	0.1%
Diisobutyl Phthalate (DIBP)	0.1%

As and when requested by our customer, Kinergy will ensure that the material and processes involved in the manufacturing of the said products will be ROHS compliant.

Kinergy also required supplier to provide appropriate Certificate of Compliance (sample attached), for our record and validation purposed.
